# Emergency Relief Program (ER)

## Disasters Declared for 2023 FFY

### CA23-1 2022 Late December Storms

- DAF submission due date extended to 07/31/2023
- Reported Damage:
  - 66 Local Agencies
  - \$140.1M in damage to fed-aid system

### Quick Release of Federal Funds

- For Disaster Event CA23-1
- \$8.7M *Still Available!*
- Available on “First-Come, First-Serve” basis
- Entire \$8.7M must be obligated by June 1, 2023 to avoid loss of Quick Release funds

### NOTE:

Disaster Event **CA23-1** covers damage before 02/24/2023

Disaster Event **CA23-3** covers damage on or after 02/24/2023

# Emergency Relief Program (ER)

## Disasters Declared for 2023 FFY

### CA23-3 2023 Late February Storms

- 52 Counties listed on governor's proclamation
- 23 counties listed on presidential major disaster proclamation
- DAF submission due date is 08/30/23

### Reported Damage:

- 28 Local Agencies
- \$52M in damage to fed-aid system

### Quick Release of Federal Funds

- For Disaster Event CA23-3
- \$4.6M *Still Available!*
- Available on "First-Come, First-Serve" basis
- Entire \$4.6M must be obligated by Sept 30, 2023 to avoid loss of Quick Release funds

# Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

## Updates

- Announcement - March 9th
- 284 projects, totaling \$228.1M of HSIP funds, \$268.9M
- All HRRR & some VRU projects will be federalized due to CA being triggered by special rules.
  - \$17.5M - HRRR (23FFY and 24FFY)- Local HSIP
  - ~ \$47M - VRU (23FFY and 24FFY) -shared with state
  - 44 - HRRR projects, totaling - \$36.6M
  - 15 - VRU projects, totaling \$15.6M (only projects over \$2M are federalized)
- Federalized projects have been sent to MPOs to program in FTIP, state funded projects can start requesting PE funds to being PD process

# Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA)

## **Remaining Apportionment: \$707,584**

San Joaquin County: \$231,000

Nevada County: \$476,584

## **Deadlines**

Allocation: September 30, 2023

Final Project Listings due to DLA by June 30, 2023 for August CTC Meeting

Obligation: September 30, 2024 – NOTE: This may change – need to obligate ASAP.

Regional funds not obligated by June 2024 are transferred to the state for obligation. Recommend obligating by April 2024.

Expenditure: September 30, 2029

# Highway Bridge Program (HBP)

## Highway Bridge Program (HBP)

Expedited Project Selection Procedures (EPSP) and Post Programming advancements opened on March 30th

Advancements into the current fiscal year possible if:

- Funds programmed in the current FTIP, if needed
- Federal milestones are met
- Any cost increases have been approved by HBP

Authorizations and Obligations of Federal Funds

- Available until HBP apportionment is gone
- As of end of April, 63 current FFY programmed projects need to come in for obligation. Any project that doesn't come in with an RFA will be put into the last FFY of FTIP when Oct FC is run.
